MESSAGE OF H.E. ELEFTHERIOS ANGHELOPOULOS, AMBASSADOR OF GREECE TO CANADA, ON THE OCCASION OF THE 193rd ANNIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY OF 25 MARCH 1821.
