ANNOUNCEMENT

The Consulate of Greece in Perth will have to temporarily stall all services to the citizens **from 20 May until 14 June**, due to transfer of its Premises.

During the aforementioned period the Consulate will only be able to deal with emergencies or Greek citizens in distress.

The Consulate of Greece would further like to inform the Public that due to the transfer it will not be feasible to attend the telephone lines, fax lines, regular mail and email during the aforementioned period. The Consulate will inform you of its new contact details as soon as the transfer is complete.

As far as visa applicants travelling to France are concerned, the Consulate would like to inform them that the Consulate General of France in Sydney will be able to entertain **urgent applications only** (for people travelling within the said period). If you have enough time until your expected departure, you are kindly requested to wait until the Greek Consulate in Perth resumes its services.

Throughout the above period, the emergency contact number (0430-194818) will be operational. We strongly advise the citizens to refrain from dialling the aforementioned number for issues that do not constitute an emergency (the following among other things **do not** constitute an emergency: passport and visa applications, registrations, powers of attorney, army exemptions, pension issues etc.). Please bear in mind that the line should stay available for the citizens who truly find themselves in an emergency.

The Consulate of Greece in Perth apologizes for any inconvenience caused due to the temporary disruption of its services and requests for your patience and cooperation. Your cooperation will enable our Staff to complete the transfer as soon as possible and resume our services at the earliest.
