The History Museum of Alexandroupolis and the Department of History and Ethnology of the Democritus University of Thrace announce an international conference with the following topic: "Alexandroupolis: the history of the town and of its broader area". The conference will be held under the auspices of the Region of Eastern Macedonia & Thrace and the Regional Unit of Evros.

The conference will take place in Alexandroupolis from the 27th to the 29th of March 2020 and it will focus on the following thematic areas:

- The establishment of the town and its name
- The demography of its population from its establishment to today
- Its urban planning and architecture
- Its religious and secular buildings
- Its financial history
- Its social and cultural history
- Its political history
- The archeological sites and the historical monuments in the town itself and in its surrounding area
- Notable people of the town

We invite the submission of individual abstracts that explore any of the above thematic areas.

The time allowance for all presentations will be 20 minutes. Presentations should be **either in Greek or in English**.
