

TRANSPORT OF ANIMALS FROM THIRD COUNTRIES

From 1 October 2004 onwards, the following conditions apply for entry of pets in Greece:

1. Direct destination Greece

Pets are not allowed to enter through points of entry when there are no approved Veterinary Border Control Stations as per list of Commission Decision 2001/881 / EC.

Pets are allowed to enter:

- Through approved BCS's
- Through entry points of the islands included in Commission Decision 94/641 / EC of the EU

List of island entry points:

1. Rhodes and its airport
2. Kos and its airport
3. Kalymnos
4. Mytilene and its airport
5. Myrina of Lemnos and its airport
6. Chios and its airport
7. Samos and its airport
8. Ermoupoli of Syros
9. Argostoli
10. Heraklion Crete and its airport
11. Chania Crete and their airport
12. Corfu and its airport

The veterinary authorities of the above points of entry are required:

- to have at their disposal a special storage area for animals where isolation is required for animals not allowed to enter until they are sent back,

- to have at their disposal a transceiver in accordance with ISO 11784 or 11785

2. Entry of dogs, cats and ferrets over three (3) yrs of age

Animals must:

(a) be identified by a microchip in accordance with ISO standard 11784 or 11785. If the animal's electronic marking does not comply with this standard, the owner of the animal must provide the means for reading the signal. Other options for identifying the animal is a clearly readable tattoo

(b) have undergone vaccination against rabies or re-vaccination, in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturing lab, with an inactivated vaccine of at least one antigen per dose, according to the World Health Organization standard

(c) have been subjected, for 30 days after vaccination and 3 months prior to their transport, to a serological check, the results of which must be titrated against antibodies greater than or equal to 0,5 UI / ml, if the animals come from countries not included in the Annex II of Chapter C of Regulation (EC) 998/2003, as amended and in force.

Subsequent transports of the same animal do not require re-testing of the antibody titre for rabies unless the vaccination protocol established by the vaccine manufacturing laboratory is interrupted,

(d) be accompanied by an individual veterinary certificate in accordance with the Annex to Commission Decision 2004/824 / EC. The certificate must be accompanied by certified copies of the results of the serological examination of the animal by the control laboratory.

3. Entrance of dogs, cats and ferrets under three (3) months old

The entry into the territory of Greece of animals less than three (3) months old, not vaccinated for rabies, is allowed if they come from countries listed in Annex II under Chapter C of Regulation (EC) 998/2003, as amended and in force, provided that:

-They are dependent on their mother and they accompany her during the transport. No more than four (4) is allowed).

-The veterinary certificate must be accompanied by a vet certificate indicating the date of birth and the characteristics of the pups.

Requirements if not accompanied by their mother:

- be identified electronically (microchip) or through a readable tattoos,
- be accompanied by an individual veterinary certificate in accordance with the Annex to Decision 2004/824 / EC. The date of the last vaccination of the mother must be indicated In point IV. This must be at least 30 days prior to the date of birth entered in point II. Additionally, the certificate must include the assuring clause that "the animal has not been in contact with wild animals and it is presumed that it has not been exposed to infection for rabies. "

Notes for guidance

1. Identification of the animal (tattoo or microchip) must have been verified before any entries are made on the certificate.
2. The rabies vaccine used must be an inactivated vaccine produced in accordance with OIE standards.
3. The certificate is **valid for four months after signature** by the official veterinarian or endorsement by the competent authority, or until the date of expiry of the vaccination shown in Part IV, whichever is earlier.
4. Animals from, or prepared in, third countries not listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003, may not enter Ireland, Malta, Sweden or the United Kingdom, either directly or via another country listed in Annex II unless brought into conformity with national rules.
5. This certificate must be accompanied by supporting documentation, or a certified copy thereof, including the identification details of the animal concerned, vaccination details and the result of the serological test.

Conditions applying (Regulation (EC) No 998/2003)

(a) Entry in a Member State other than Ireland, Malta, Sweden and the United Kingdom

1. from a third country listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003:
Parts I, II, III and IV must be completed (and VII for Finland).
In case of a subsequent movement to Finland, Part VII and to Ireland, Malta, Sweden or the United Kingdom, Parts V, VI and VII must be completed in compliance with national rules, and may be completed in a country listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003.
2. from a third country not listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003:
Parts I, II, III, IV and V must be completed (and VII for Finland). The sample referred to in Part V must have been taken more than three months before the entry. For subsequent movement to Ireland, Malta, Sweden or the United Kingdom — see note 4. In case of a subsequent movement to Finland, Part VII must be completed (see (a)(1) above).

(b) Entry in Ireland, Malta, Sweden and the United Kingdom

1. from a third country listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003:
Parts I, II, III, IV, V, VI and VII must be completed (Parts III, V, VI and VII complying with national rules).
2. from a third country not listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 998/2003:
The certificate is not valid — see note 4.
