## **BIOGRAPHY**

Alexandra Spyratos is a Greek International artist, known for her colourful and bold depiction of the African wildlife. Influenced by her life between Africa, Europe and Australia, translating the heat and the exotic beauty of the African savannah to canvas has become Spyratos' passion and spiritual goal.

Alexandra's paintings are rich and textured with layers of variegated golds, copper leaf, coloured silver, glitter, inks, pastel crayon and acrylics, all masterfully recreating the physicality of the wild that inspires her. With forty-two solo shows including exhibitions in New York, London, Milan, Miami, Hong Kong, Venice, Vienna, Paris, Switzerland, Greece, South Africa, Uganda, Kenya, Nigeria, Portugal, Spain and Australia, Alexandra continues to expand her creative world, exploring and evolving in her individual contemporary style that famously straddles all genre.

"Big Tusk Herds" is created with a special technique using red soil from Tsavo National Park where the artist does her sketching of the African wildlife. Layered with the soil that the elephants walk on, acrylic, patina and pure silver dyed in greens, the artist creates a textured rendition of the Tsavo Savannah grasslands where the big tusk herds roam.
