**According to your level, by the end of this course, you will be able to:**

<p><b>A1</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ read and write in Greek</li><li>▪ Understand and use a basic vocabulary regarding topics of your personal sphere such as family, work, hobbies etc.</li><li>▪ Interact in simple daily communicational situations (introduce yourself and others, order in a restaurant, book a room in a hotel, buy a ticket etc.)</li><li>▪ write a short and simple text regarding familiar topics</li><li>▪ recognize daily habits and behaviors of the Greek people</li></ul>
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<p><b>A2</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ understand short simple texts on familiar topics</li><li>▪ understand short sentences spoken by native speakers in a formal or friendly situation</li><li>▪ respond to and interact in simple everyday situations (shopping, work, fun, health, food, etc)</li><li>▪ write short texts in simple structure</li><li>▪ recognize characteristic habits and behavior of Greek people</li></ul>

- Enrich your vocabulary in various topics (social relations, travels, shopping interactions etc.)
- delve deeper into grammatical and syntactic skills of this level
- practice your oral speech through discussions and role-playing activities
- converse fluently and spontaneously with native speakers, describe an event and clarify information
- improve your pronunciation
- develop your written speech to a more complex level
- encounter aspects of Greek culture from the classic era until nowadays

- understand the basic and key points in authentic texts of various content
- enrich your vocabulary with topics that interest you
- delve deeper into grammatical and syntactic phenomena of this level
- improve your oral speech through discussions and role-playing activities on common topics
- converse fluently and spontaneously with natural speakers
- improve your pronunciation
- produce clearly written texts on issues of immediate, personal interest
- acquaint with basic characteristics of modern Greek culture (daily life, interpersonal relationships and mentalities)
