Students who are citizens of specified Southeast European countries (i.e. Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Kosovo (under UNSC Resolution 1244) Montenegro, Romania, Serbia, and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia) and who are not in

receipt of a scholarship from any other source may apply for a fees waiver.

For the academic year 2017-2018, the Programme will receive up to twenty-five graduate students. Applicants can submit their applications from January 9 till June 16,

2017.
