The Ordinance imposes a 7-day quarantine for all persons entering the Republic of

The Ordinance does not apply to the following categories of persons:

- the border for reasons of daily labour migration; neighbouring country or provide a signed declaration justifying their crossing of Cross-border migrant workers who present a certificate of employment in the
- of the date and hour of the funeral; leave, and return to, the Republic of Slovenia in the same day and present proof Persons attending the funeral of a close relative in the neighbouring country who
- in transit freight transport; Persons engaged in the transport of goods to or from the Republic of Slovenia, or
- Slovenia to another country in a single day; Slovenian citizens and foreign nationals travelling through the Republic of
- Holders of diplomatic passports;
- Providers of essential services holding a certificate issued by the competent
- Slovenia who have crossed the border in the line of duty; brigades, and Members of protection and relief services, health services, the Police, persons engaged in humanitarian transports for the Republic of fire
- in agricultural activities Persons who own or lease land on both sides of the state border and are engaged
