ANNOUNCEMENT

for the recruitment of local agents for the visa department of the Consulate of Greece in Cape Town

The Consulate of Greece in Cape Town, within the framework of the program «Support with "Fieldworkers" to Consular Authorities in Third Countries» of the European Internal Security Fund/Borders and Visa Section 2014-2020, announces its intention to recruit two (2) staff members with limited duration contracts of eight (8) months, to cover emergency needs in the Visa Section of the Consulate of Cape Town. The above contracts are not renewed, until three months after the expiry date.

REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must have:

1. South African permanent residence permit or domicile in the area of the Consular jurisdiction of Cape Town
2. University degree/diploma or currently have the status of an undergraduate university student
3. Knowledge of the English language, written and spoken.
4. Computer skills
5. Knowledge of the Greek language is an additional asset
6. Applicants must be between the ages of 21 – 60

Gross salary is 850 Euros (payable in South African Rands)
