GOOD FILMS...THAT HAPPEN TO BE GREEK!

ALL CATS ARE BRILLIANT (SYNHARITIRIA STOUS AISIODOXOUS)

A young woman struggles to find her place in a world that holds her back from realizing her aspirations.

BLACK BOX

Rehearsals for a performance at the National School of Dance in Athens become a study in the eloquence of the human body. (Free event)

BOY EATING THE BIRD'S FOOD (TO AGORI TROEI TO FAGITO TOY POULIOU)

A disturbed young man, estranged from family and friends, lives on the brink of starvation. Winner: Best Picture, Hellenic Film Academy. (Adults only)

GREEK AMERICAN RADICALS: THE UNTOLD STORY (TAXISYNEIDISIA)

A history of Greek American radicalism, from the period of mass migration to the McCarthy years.

HELLO ANATOLIA

A young Greek American goes to Izmir, Turkey to connect with his family's roots in Anatolia.

JOY (HARA)

A woman kidnaps an infant from a clinic to raise as her own. Her trial proves to be a travesty of justice.

MARJORAM (MATZOURANA)

A precocious young girl begins to act strangely, puzzling her parents and causing concern for her own safety.

KISSES TO THE CHILDREN (FILIA EIS TA PAIDIA)

Five survivors give enthralling accounts of how they were saved by fellow Greeks during the German occupation.

MAGIC HOUR

No level of Greek society is spared from satirical scrutiny in this funny but sobering road movie, the most talked about Greek film of the year.

NAKED HANDS (GYMNA HERIA)

The American career of great conductor Dimitri Mitropoulos is examined through archival footage and his personal correspondence. (Free event)

Famed wine producer Yannis Boutaris decides to run for mayor of Thessaloniki.

PAPADOPOULOS AND SONS

A financially-ruined millionaire reluctantly goes into the fish and chips business with his free-wheeling brother. (English)

THE TREE AND THE SWING (TO DENDRO KAI I KOUNIA)

A daughter attempts to reconcile with her estranged father in this gripping story of repentance, acceptance and love.

WHAT IF (AN)

Two parallel stories of a seemingly confirmed bachelor show how life can be changed by a chance encounter or an action not taken.

Directors Vassilis Loules and Chris Emmanouilides present their films A BRIGHT SHINING SUN and ARCHIVE and talk about their film experiences.
