Program "Routes in Teaching Greek as a Second/Foreign Language" for teachers in Greece and abroad

The Centre for the Greek Language announces the new period of the distance learning program "Routes in Teaching Greek as a Second/Foreign Language" for teachers in Greece and abroad (http://diadromes.greek-language.gr). The course begins on Monday, October 2nd 2017 and lasts for 10 months. Registrations are accepted from 03-07-2017 until 18/09/2017 at www.greek-language.gr/routes.

The program is implemented entirely on distance mode and consists of the following eight modules, which cover all thematic areas of interest for the teacher of Greek as a second/foreign language:

- 1. Syllabus Design, Classroom Management and Learning Strategies
- 2. Teaching Grammar, Vocabulary and Pronunciation
- 3. Teaching Languages to Young Learners
- 4. Language Performance Assessment
- 5. Computer Assisted Language Learning
- 6. Aspects of Language
- 7. Bilingualism: Language and Thought in the Bilingual Speaker
- 8. When Cultures Converse at School: Intercultural Education Issues

The program is addressed to anyone involved and/or interested in teaching Greek as a second/foreign language in Greece and abroad, provided he/she is a **B.A. holder from departments of Greek philology, foreign philology, pedagogical studies, theological studies or other departments of Greek or equivalent foreign universities.** Candidates who have not completed tertiary education are also admitted under conditions.

The program provides a **certified specialization** in teaching Greek as a second/foreign language and belongs to the qualifications that are accepted among others for the recruitment of permanent teachers in Hosting Structures for Refugee Education according to article 8 par. 3(d) of M.D. No $152360/\Gamma\Delta4/19.9.2016$ (Government Gazette 3049/B/23.9.2016).
